

Research Analyst – Student Position

Overview:

RISE-Israel is looking for a part-time analyst to assist in research efforts.

The role involves assisting to produce research on issues related to innovation policy and to the Israeli high-tech ecosystem (e.g. survival of startups, investment trends, characteristics of entrepreneurs, etc.).

The job holder will assist in analyzing the data, drawing conclusions from it, and presenting it.

This position is suitable for someone who is seeking to gain experience in economic research and policy analysis.

Who are we? RISE-Israel (formerly SNPI) is an independent non-profit think tank assisting in the development of a long-term vision and policies to strengthen the Israeli economy, with a focus on the tech innovation ecosystem.

NOTE: The position will be part-time (3 days per week) and will be partly remote.

Roles and Responsibilities:

- Research global and local macro trends and developments within the Israeli innovation ecosystem
- Find and analyze data from both in-house and external sources
- Conduct qualitative and quantitative research
- Assess the quality of the data and clean it as necessary
- Present data and insights in a clear and concise format

Qualifications:

- Studying for degree in economics, data science, statistics, or similar.
- Proven research achievements (academic or in the workforce)
- Strong numerical abilities
- High-level proficiency in English (reading and writing)
- Intermediate proficiency in statistical software (R, Stata, or Matlab)
- Good communication skills
- Quick and comprehensive self-learner
- Ability to work independently
